## Installation

- 1. Remove Fixture from box
- 2. Connect fixture lead to 12V DC/AC power source, using approved splice method



3. Connect fixture lead to light fixture, and push connection into light fixture






4. Install light fixture on mounting base (supplied by others) or direct bury. Examples of mounting base include, but not limited to: 2" rigid conduit, 2' floor Flange, (Hali-Brite part # 1067-0002) Hali-Brite Base Can and Cover (Hali-Brite part #L867OLCAN&BP)



## 5. Apply 12V DC OR AC power to circuit and visually inspect light fixture.



# **Maintainence:**

### 1. Replacing Lamps:

A. Remove lens by removing tamper resistant screw (using #8x 1/2" hex head with button)







- b. Replace lamp with 12VDC/AC LED lamp, 5w max.c. Replace Lens and re-secure #8 Tamper resistant screw.
